

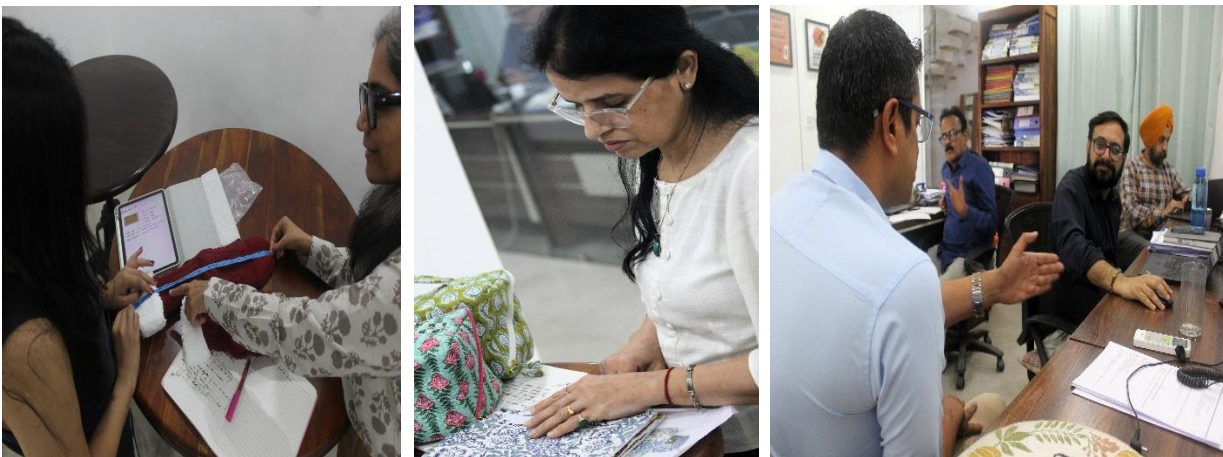


How India Enables Supply Chain Diversification for Global Brands
